- Daniel explained some requirements as Chair of this committee.
- Updates on funding for WCAT:
- Bill joined town council meeting on Monday 11/27/23 and was officially sworn in as being a "communication member" for us.
- Brian (speaking) was on the board at WCAT, but currently a volunteer.
- Mr. Ryan Boyd took over for Mr. Tom Stapleton at the end of 2019 for Executive Director
- Ian McDemott is the new Executive Director
- Looking for the 5<sup>th</sup> person to hire now.
- There is a meeting for WCAT scheduled for 12/13/2023
- People can do a quick tour if they like.
- 2 Federal level notes
  - Protecting community television act
    - Cable companies can NOT reduce their fees.
  - HR3557 proposes to make Broadband more accessible.
    - Cable Companies can cancel their agreements but still provide service to towns.

- This would have detrimental effects
- State Level
  - Streaming companies new taxes
    - 40% to Municipalities
    - Rest to local access station
    - New tax most likely to consumers
    - Went to committee.
    - No 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting scheduled yet.
  - Couple of other bills "floating around"
    - All meetings have to be "hybrid"
    - And/OR all meetings must be "remote"
    - Not a lot of movement on these two
  - Bills have to be discharged by committee by 2/7/2024
  - Question as to why there were 9 members named but only 8 official members now
- Dan mentioned we want to get as much funding as possible for WCAT or equivalent to provide these services.
- WCAT is listed as a separate account now, which is a good thing.
- Still discussion on how to fund WCAT
  - Taxes from town
  - Additional taxes from streaming services
- WCAT benefits the town
  - We don't want to lose their service
- Shane mentioned that WCAT is important for many events (sporting, committees, etc)
  - Inflation is causing costs to rise not go down.
- Bill feels ready for meeting in a couple of weeks.
  - We look forward to Bill's feedback.
- We want to schedule our next meeting close enough to get accurate and timely feedback from Bill
- April time frame is the discussion at this point.
  - o April 22, 2024, 7pm
  - Agreed upon date
- Shane to write up summary for annual report.
  - Dan brought up the motion (2<sup>nd</sup> by Shane) and Dan will oversee and approve the summary
