- 2) General discussion surrounding the FY2024 budget and beyond. The committee remains concerned that overspending will result in a serious decline in reserves and potential depletion. It was pointed out that if the previous trend of departments returning excess funds to the general fund at Fiscal Years end as well as increasing revenues continues, we will remain solvent but will not meet our policy objective of 10% reserves on an annual basis in a few fiscal yearstime. It was noted by Chairman Sherman that budgets must be reviewed with an eye toward limiting annual increase to 4% or less. It was also projected that the School Department would return \$500,000 to the general fund at the close of FY2023 (total department returns projected to be \$1.5 Million).
