2) The following FY2021 Budgets were presented:

Insurance- It was noted that the increase in this budget reflected the value of Town properties, increase in the number of Town vehicles and the addition of a cyber liability policy.

Workers Compensation- It was noted that our losses for this year are very low which could have a very positive effect on future budgets.

DPW- Director Joseph Conway presented the DPW, Snow and Ice, Water and Sewer budgets. Jim Sullivan and Dennis Hogan presented a report of the Subcommittee. Committee members noted the effects of the Collins study and the reclassification of the laborer's union positions and how that affected the budget. The board also discussed the assignment of expenses between Tax Levy, Water and Sewer accounts. It was also noted that the budget does not reflect any collective bargaining agreement for Fiscal Year 2021 for the Supervisors Union.

3) Approval of Minutes:

After a brief discussion on the general content of minutes. Gerard Leeman moved seconded by Evan Kenney to approve the minutes dated February 13, 2020 as amended. Motion passed unanimously.
