#### ACE Building

- ACE Building Front Projection Sign
  - Installed on Patriots Day; sign wiring pending. Invoice has been sent for final payment
  - Buntings updated (purchased from Blanchard Awning)
  - Great Job by Sardella Display & Signs and by John Connors Sign Installation & Flag Pole Service (offered future bunt change out service and Flagpole on roof)
  - Open item: explore where to put front flag pole as fixture is where sign is now

### • Building Maintenance

- Recent building alarm issues reported to DPW, but alarm has not been malfunctioning much lately; will continue to monitor
- Rear alley cleaning and gate moving it looks great! Fence chained up and padlock installed to protect electrical and for general safety. Future plan: move gate next to rear entrance door.

### • Lighting & Ceiling Painting Projects (New front sign wiring and 1<sup>st</sup> floor gallery lighting)

- Electrical install estimate received from Sanibel Electric. Minimal lead-time required. \$9,800 estimate for wiring the gallery and new sign wiring
- Working with Testa Lighting. \$2,800 estimate includes fixture schedule assistance/guidance, getting pricing info, managing bid, and supervising install
- Radiator removal on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor needs to be scheduled for new sign light\timer install.
- o Open items: who to remove old ceiling fixtures and new fixture costs
- Next steps are the fixture schedule; need to create specifications
- Waiting on Ceiling painting estimates
- Flooring Project
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Test results and abatement\encapsulation options discussed with DPW.
  - Abatement estimate is \$9,800 DPW exploring covering/sharing the cost
  - Abatement crew lead-time is within two weeks.
- Main Floor Wall Air Handler
  - Air handler not viable option given tall ceilings. Exploring other options. Not an immediate priority
- Overall Projects Timing: Looking to summer months for primary ceiling and floor activity
- Architect Updates: \$5,100 invoice for recent architecture support and activity

#### Programming / Events

- 'New Beginnings' Show
  - $\circ$  'New Beginnings' art show to be taken down soon due to upcoming building improvements.
  - Thank you to the artists who participated and to the Savings Bank and the local community for all of the support.
- Looking to schedule several annual WHS art shows in May and June

- If the event is a fundraiser activity, then a 5% fee is due to the Albion Cultural Exchange building
