### **ACE Building**

#### ACE Entrance ADA Remediation:

- The architect is working with Ann Waite on the bid set of drawings. Chris is working with Ann on abutter communication on rear entrance plans and easement.
- There was discussion on several rear entrance style options including overall design and lighting types and locations. Input and questions for the architect were provided.

## ACE Building Sign:

- Chris met with the Design Review Board and received recommendation input and approvals on the information needed to proceed with the next step which is to meet with the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA). Chris to file ZBA application for their December meeting.
- Once the entire approvals process has been completed, the sign can be built. Based on current sign requirements, the current sign invoice is \$5,900. The ACE committee members unanimously agreed on providing sign funding not to exceed \$8,000 that would be informed/ modified by the remaining approval recommendations/needs.

#### Bathrooms

- An issue was reported to the DPW on an apparent sewer back up into both 1<sup>st</sup> floor bathrooms.
- The tile work remediation is outstanding and a future effort.

#### **Envision Project - Albion Street Scape Upgrade activities**

• The latest info from the Envision project is that the ACE building will be included in Phase II and not Phase 1 as had previously been communicated. Phase 1 starts at Foster Street and goes down Albion towards North Ave. The ACE committee looks forwards to working on Phase II.

### Arts Collaborative of Wakefield (ACW)

• The ACW group recently met to discuss how to best function in the current COVID 19 situation and to explore how to support our members and possible events, including virtual and non-virtual. After much discussion, there was agreement to regroup in January 2021 to assess the COVID 19 reality at that time and to determine if future virtual/non-virtual events were feasible.

#### **Programming / Events**

Nothing is in the event queue due to the Impact of COVID 19.

#### **ACE Funding**

- Chris to pursue info on a state level grant program for handicap accessibility projects.
- Chris recently came across the concept of community/ arts development funding via local fees. There was discussion and interest in understanding and pursuing this as a possible avenue for funding.
