**Public Hearing:
revisions to regulations restricting the sale of Tobacco Regulations**

The BOH held a public hearing to revise the current Tobacco Regulations. Clay will send a letter to all tobacco permit holders with the new language that will go into effect on April 9th 2018.

Silva motions to accept changes to the tobacco regulations. Mehlman seconded the motion. Motion passes 3-0-0.

**Public Hearing:
revisions to regulations prohibiting the sale of Drug Paraphernalia**

The BOH held a public hearing to revise the drug paraphernalia regulations. Sections 3.4 (1) Products manufactured for the use of marijuana may be sold only in those businesses that do not allow people under the age of 21 from entering the business. The new regulations will go into effect on July 1st 2018. Clay will send a letter to all permit holders with the new language.
