

Five ways to provide a more environmental sustainable public event



1. Provide Zero Waste Stations

🗑 Stations should separate recycling, compost, and land-fill waste.

🗑 Provide tall signage to locate the waste station.

🗑 Provide signage with graphics and text to explain how to sort the waste.

🗑 Provide a volunteer at each station to answer questions.



2. No Helium Balloons

🎈 Avoid use of all helium balloons. Helium balloons should not be distributed or displayed to avoid accidental release.



3. Compostible Supplies

🍴 All food vendors use only compostible disposal cutlery, tableware, and straws. Avoid paper, plastic, and styrofoam plates, bowls, cups, and forks.



4. Water Stations

💧 Provide a water bottle refill truck.

💧 Post maps to locate the nearest public indoor and outdoor water filling stations.

💧 Encourage visitors and vendors to provide their own water bottles.



5. Sustainable Travel

🚲 When advertising the event, provide a map locating the nearest public transit stations, bike racks and EV charging stations.
