  - Climate leaders program requires completing a Decarbonization roadmap for municipal operations; a Technical Assistance grant will be made available for us to apply to pay for this roadmap to be done
  - Julie to bring our climate plan idea and Climate Leaders aspirations to Town Council in April
  - Subcommittee members will work on stripping out key and applicable action items for commercial and residential from comparable town climate action plans as a starting point for our climate plan.
  - Once we have Decarbonization roadmap (municipal operations) and climate plan actions for commercial and residential, we will put both together for town wide climate action plan
  - We will engage with community members and ESC student liaisons for our climate plan creation
