IECC

Halloween Pumpkin Drop Off Drive	initiatives in schools to attend the meeting. S. Veilleux suggested that Bob Schiaroli, Director of Facilities for schools to be invited to a future meeting. With permission from Bob Schiaroli, ESC with Black Earth Compost will organize a Halloween pumpkin drop off at the schools. Dates and times TBD. WMGLD Clean Lake Committee	Recently, WMGLD adapted revised residential rebates, including wifi thermostat, and heat pumps. WMGLD will be hosting public forums on changes. Commercial and industrial customer rebates coming. At a recent Town Council meeting, they formed the Clean Lake Committee which included a seat for an ESC representative. The committee goal is to make Lake Quannapowitt swimmable and fishable. R Darnell was appointed to represent the committee.
Pollination Gardens/ Bees	R Darnell is talking with Bob Schiaroli regarding funding for gardens in schools, and similar efforts.
Wakefield Communi- TREE Program	At a recent Town Council meeting, they approved a CommuniTREE program under DPW to add more trees in town. ESC supports more shade trees. R.Greenberg noted that it all likelihood, not all street trees will be native because the trees have a very limited criteria before they are select, i.e. straight roots, handles exposure to salt, etc.
	ESC encourages DPW and WMGLD to water and maintain tree after planting for at least a year to help ensure that they will survive.
UU Church Wakefield Climate Action	M Sessions plans to attend UU Church's Climate Action event. She will report back to comment.
Global Climate Strike	Boston's Climate Strike is September 20^{th} at $11:30$ am at Boston City Hall Plaza. Adults are encouraged to support students striking by attending.
EV Charge Points	At the Sept $23^{\rm rd}$ Town Council meeting, J Galvin-Smith is scheduled to discuss EV charging stations.

Other Issues It was brought to the attention of the committee that an 8,000 sf single house

was under construction in a neighborhood with more modest homes on modest lots. The home is being built by-right, without a zoning variance. Neighbors are worried of potential McMansions becoming more common in town. ESC will look into options the town could have to address this concern.
