• Flying the flag at the Civic Center presented potential problems. Town Council decided last year that for Flags to fly, they have to rent the Civic Center. It is an

impossibility right now. Town Administrator advised the Commission to ask for a waiver from Town Council.

- There is a problem with the size of the pole at the Civic Center. Any other flag has to be fit under the US Flag.
- Potentially, for future events, we can explore the possibility of flying the flag at Town Hall or to "rent" the Hall for a Fall Raising Ceremony.
- Sub-committee is going to explore alternative ways to celebrate Pride 2020, among many ideas:
- Have a virtual Cultural Event in a Platform like Facebook Life. The candidate for this year is Alastair Moock.
- We would like to distribute flags or signs to be put on yards. The agreement was not to collect money but use our Town of Wakefield's Fund. Also, a majority of commissioners were in favor of using the most inclusive trans flag, which includes transgender groups, rather than handing out different flags.
- Have virtual story time, in different languages. Possibly partner with the library.
