<u>Chris Farrand</u> is the State Director Emergency Disaster Services and the Greater Boston Social Services Director for the Salvation Army. Chris and his team provide support services. Chris will give a brief presentation of the services his unit provides and their response to the Columbia Gas Incident.

The Salvation Army canteen and crew deployed to the Operation Staging area and Evacuee Reception Centers to provide hydration, snacks, meals and emotional and spiritual care to responding personnel and local residents. Between Thursday afternoon and Friday morning, the EDS personnel have served: More than 1000 meals, 2350 snacks, 1660 beverages, 770 cups of coffee.

<u>June Somers</u> is the President of the South Shore Food Truck Association and the owner/operator of Mom On the Go Grilled Cheese Food Truck. June was called for assistance during the Merrimack Valley Gas Explosions. She will discuss the availability and role of Food Trucks in local emergency situations.

<u>Mike Castro</u> is a retired deputy chief of the Newton Fire Department and a consultant. Mike will give a presentation on CAMEO. The CAMEO system integrates a chemical database and a method to manage the data, an air dispersion model, and a mapping capability. All modules work interactively to share and display critical information in a timely fashion. The CAMEO system is available in Macintosh and Windows formats. It is being used throughout the United States, and around the world by government agencies, and private companies – providing the ability to share information with responders and other planning partners. This presentation will introduce the modules so that planners will become aware of, or become more familiar with this important tool. The suite is available as a download free of charge from the U.S. EPA website.
