After the posting, the Project Team continued to work on the logistics and are now in the process of developing phasing plans that do not require the use of Burnett Field, the tennis courts or any other field for temporary parking. However, Burnett Field will have to be offline for the Spring/Summer 2024 for the replacement of the culvert that runs beneath the field and its headwall at the wetlands. The Project Team is working hard to minimize impact to the school and all sports amenities."
