# 2024 YARD WASTE, MERCURY RECYCLING, AND HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE SCHEDULE

## Nahant Street Yardwaste Site

Residents can obtain a permit to use the Nahant Street Yardwaste Site for disposal of leaves, grass, clippings, shrubs, and brush. Permits are \$25 and can be obtained at the DPW office in Town Hall or online at [www.wakefield.ma.us/online-payments](http://www.wakefield.ma.us/online-payments). Proof of residency is required. Permits must be renewed annually.

Yard waste must be curbside prior to 7 a.m. in biodegradable paper bags or barrels. No plastic bags will be collected. Cut branches into 3' lengths or less and tie in bundles no more than 18" in diameter.
