Charles Winship was one of the owners of the Winship Boit Knitting Mill, which employed a large number of Wakefield residents.

New Matters: The door of the Americal must be replaced. Buildings Manager Chris Pierce has sent proposed plans. The Commission unanimously agrees to approve the plans.
