From that point forward all types of multi-family housing has been the focus. For summer work during the college years, Robert worked in the construction field. This along with his interested in building assemblies has contributed to providing very detailed and complete construction drawings and specifications. Attention to the details is well respected by the contractors. Recently the interest in construction components has turned towards high performance buildings.
