

Youth Council Meeting Minutes - March 2, 2023

Item 1 | Call to Order

• Vanessa Westlake called the meeting into order at 5:04 p.m.

Item 2 | Attendance

Item 3 | Public Comment

- State Senator Jason Lewis gave a presentation to the members of the Youth Council about the
 survey responses his office received about what issues young people (aged 17 and under) are
 interested in in the 5th Middlesex District. Some of the issues highlighted as important by
 young people were supporting immigrant rights, making public higher education more
 affordable and reducing student debt, strengthening gun safety laws, improving mental health
 and substance use disorder treatment and recovery, etc. Senator Lewis explained how he has
 filed and cosponsored many bills advancing these issues.
- Vanessa Westlake asked about the top issues for other age groups, to which Senator Lewis
 responded by saying improving mental health, healthcare affordability, supporting public
 schooling, protecting environmental and open spaces.
- Ali Atoui noted that protecting the environment and open spaces scored high on the survey, and correlated this to the Youth Council's recent presentation from OSRP. Thus, he asked about some bills in the current session addressing this, to which Senator Lewis said that a major public land protection and environmental law was passed in the last session, and that funding for environmental agencies is an important task for the current session.
- Ahmed Othman asked about the civic engagement bills Senator Lewis has filed or
 cosponsored, to which Senator Lewis responded by saying that a civic learning project was
 mandated by law during a past session, and that he has specifically filed bills making official
 meetings still have a hybrid option post-pandemic, and having local cable access TV stations
 receive alternative funding aside from just cable.
- Vanessa Westlake asked about how the Youth Council could work with Senator Lewis's office
 further, to which he responded by saying to stay engaged in issues affecting youth, potentially
 coordinating with his office a time to visit the State House, and to stay in contact about any
 opportunities.

Item 4 | Approval of Meeting Minutes from January 11, 2023 and February 8, 2023



Clerk Ali Atoui gave a brief summary on both the January 11 and February 8 Youth Council
meetings, due to him being absent during the preceding meeting. Ahmed Othman motioned,
with Madeline Naper seconding, to approve the minutes; they were both approved
unanimously.

Item 5 | Liaison Spotlight: Town Council

- Vanessa Westlake gave a presentation to the Town Council since Madeline Naper (the liaison)
 was sick at the time, and informed the body about what the Youth Council has done over the
 past term.
- Town Councilor Jonathan Chines gave an update on what the Town Council has been doing, specifically with the town budget, renewing the contract with the town administrator, and the new high school project.

members, and in another location for the middle school members.

- Ali Atoui announced that the subcommittee is moving forward with the Instagram Reels to highlight the current state of the high school, in advance of the Special Election.
- Ali Atoui also noted efforts to increase voter registration amongst seniors at the high school.
- Ali Atoui presented the in-progress Youth Interest Survey to display what questions students
 of the WMHS would answer about what they'd like to see the Youth Council take on. He
 subsequently opened it up to the general council to see what additional topics could be asked
 about. Catherine Dhingra suggested everyone give a potential topic that relates to their liaison
 positions to expand the topic importance section. Vanessa Westlake suggested announcing
 the survey over the morning announcements to increase awareness.
